

How to apply for Board member of HOPE or Ambassador of HOPE

Rules and procedure for candidates for member of the Board of HOPE

A member of the Board has to be a HOPE member and a professional with experience in the field of hospital teaching. A member of the Board can be elected for a period of two years and can be reelected by the General Assembly.

The candidates for the Board can apply as candidate for becoming Board member of HOPE four months before the General Assembly.

The candidates should provide a curriculum vitae and should express what they wish to do in the Board of HOPE and what they can offer. During the General Assembly the candidates present themselves to the General Assembly and thereafter the General Assembly votes.

Rules and procedure for candidates for Ambassador of HOPE

The Ambassador of HOPE has to be a HOPE member and a professional with experience in the field of hospital teaching. The Ambassador can be elected for a period of two years and can be re-elected by the General Assembly.

The Ambassador is the Chairman of the panel that assesses the proposal for the appointment of someone as Honorary Member.

Members of HOPE can apply as candidate for becoming Ambassador of HOPE four months before the General Assembly. The candidates should provide a curriculum vitae and they should express what they wish to do in HOPE and what they can offer. During the General Assembly the candidates present themselves to the General Assembly and thereafter the General Assembly votes.
